## Saskatchewan Nonprofit Partnership **Privacy Policy**

Privacy Policy: The Saskatchewan Nonprofit Partnership (SNP) is committed to respecting and protecting the privacy of every individual who uses this website or signs up to interact with us through social media channels by ensuring the appropriate management and protection of any personal information that you agree to provide. SNP strives to comply with all Privacy and Canadian Anti-Spam Law (CASL) Legislation.

**Personal Information:** Personal information is defined as being any information that can be used to distinguish, identify, or contact a specific individual. Business contact information and certain publicly available information, such as names, addresses, and telephone numbers published in telephone directories and on-line public databases are not considered personal information. SNP does not share personal information obtained through our website or social media channels with any third parties, except with persons who are contracted to administer our information technology requirements and who agree to comply with our policies and requirements for the privacy and confidentiality of personal information.

Consent: Your knowledge and consent is required for the direct collection, use or disclosure of your personal information except where mandated by law. This consent may be either expressed or implied. Express consent can be given either orally, electronically, or in writing. Implied consent is consent that can reasonably be inferred from an individual's action or inaction.

**Limiting Collection**: The collection of your personal information shall be limited to that which is necessary for the purposes identified by SNP. Information shall be collected by fair and lawful means. SNP will not collect information indiscriminately. When SNP collects personal information directly from its constituents, SNP will identify the purposes for which personal information is collected at or before the time of collection. These purposes will be limited to those related to SNP's projects and activities and which a reasonable person would consider to be appropriate in the circumstances.

Limiting Use, Disclosure, and Retention: Your personal information shall not be used or disclosed for purposes other than those for which it was collected, except with the consent of the individual or as required by law. Your personal information shall be retained for as long as the purpose for which the information was originally collected remains valid. SNP will not disclose your personal information to third parties except in accordance with the terms of its privacy policies or unless required to do so as part of an internal investigation or other law enforcement purpose, or as required by law. SNP does not sell, rent, or trade mailing lists.

Accuracy: SNP will use its best efforts to ensure that personal information it collects and uses is accurate, complete, and up to date.

Safeguards: SNP is obligated to protect your personal information by making reasonable security arrangements against such risks as unauthorized access, collection, use, disclosure, or disposal. Third parties are expected to safeguard your personal information entrusted to them in a manner consistent with the policies of SNP.

Individual Access: Upon request, you shall be informed of the existence, use, or disclosure of your personal information and shall be given access to that information. You shall be able to challenge the accuracy and completeness of the information and have it amended as appropriate. Individuals may review the personal information SNP has recorded for that individual, and only for that individual. An individual may also provide written permission to SNP to permit another individual to review the personal information SNP has recorded for that individual, and only for that individual.

Links to other Websites: To provide you with a better service, our website provides you with a number of links to other local, national, and international organizations. When connecting to these websites you will no longer be subject to SNP's Privacy Policy, but to the privacy policy of the new site.
