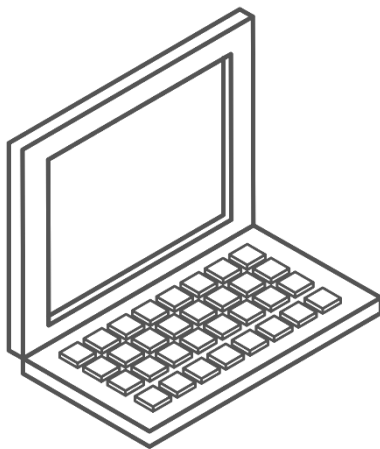


# Using VolunteerConnector amid COVID-19

**VolunteerConnector** provides organizations with free access to post unlimited volunteer positions for province-wide volunteer recruiting. It enables people to find local volunteer opportunities across Saskatchewan that match their interests and skills.

VolunteerConnector has made it easier to respond to urgent volunteer opportunities through adding a "**COVID-19**" tag to our cause categories. Volunteers can search quickly using that tag to find opportunities to respond to.

## Some tips for posting amid COVID-19:

- If you have an immediate need, use the COVID-19 tag (e.g. if you serve seniors or are a Food Bank).
- Revisit your current opportunities and update with the COVID-19 tag if applicable, and archive posts that are no longer relevant.
- If you are organizing a grassroots community effort you are welcome to use VolunteerConnector for posting and organizing

## Virtual Volunteering

Organizations can also post virtual volunteering opportunities. At a time where people have more available time and a need to connect with and support others, we can help facilitate this in safe and meaningful ways. Here are some ideas for virtual volunteer opportunities that can be done at home:

### Project Development

- Project proposal writing
- Manage website content and functionality
- Manage social media posting and response
- Create project management plan for new service

### Research

- Analysis of legal frameworks
- Research donor engagement opportunities
- Review and summarize key government reports and positions
- Develop reference material

### Writing & Editing

- Digital content editor
- Social media content for upcoming event
- Create course content for new trainings

### Technology & Design

- Create videos or screencasts
- Develop data visualization tools or Powerpoints
